I am directed to state that on consideration of the recommendations made by the Expert Committee which assessed the proposal on April 5, 1993 and subsequent review report received, the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) has accorded approval to the Vidya Vardhini Society for establishment of an Engineering College at Vasai to conduct the following full time degree courses in Engineering for two academic years (1994-95 & 1995-96):


The approval given above is subject to the following conditions:

- (1) The Society shall start construction of a new separate building on 8.5 acres land immediately. The plan of construction should be such that atleast 2000 sq. mt. of plinth area is completed in one year and every year additional 2000 sq. mt. is added till a total of 8136 sq. mt. plinth area is completed.
- (2) The facilities for existing Polytechnic may be utilised only for holding the 1st year classes of the Degree programmes and separate facilities must be available by the end of March, 1995.

3. The required faculty be recruited in phases so as to bring the total faculty members as per AICTE requirement.
4. A qualified Principal of the College must be recruited as per AICTE requirement by the end of May, 1994.
5. The Society must submit a registered undertaking for fulfillment of the general conditions of the AICTE.
6. No new course shall be started in the Engineering College without the prior approval of the AICTE.
7. The intake in any year shall not be altered without the prior approval of the AICTE.
8. The AICTE scales of pay shall be introduced for the teaching and other staff from the date of according this approval.
9. The Management including the Governing Council of the College shall be constituted as per the AICTE guidelines and also the Chairman shall be appointed as per the AICTE guidelines.
10. Admissions shall be made on merit as per the guidelines issued by the AICTE and no capitation or donation of any kind shall be charged for admissions.
11. The tuition and other fees shall be charged as prescribed by the State Government within the overall criteria prescribed by the AICTE from time to time.
12. The teaching staff shall be recruited on an All India basis by open selection, and as per procedure, qualifications, experience, etc. as prescribed by the AICTE from time to time. State-based selection would be permissible for such posts for which the State Government prescribes "State-based selection" as a general policy.
13. The accounts of the College shall be audited by a Chartered Accountant and be open for inspection by the AICTE or anybody authorized by it.
14. The College shall follow strictly any further conditions as may be laid down by the AICTE from time to time.

This approval is also subject to full compliance with the SCHEME as prescribed by the Supreme Court in its judgement dated 4.2.1993 on W.P. (C) No. 607 of 1992 with other WPs in the case of Unnikrishnan, J.P. and other etc. etc. vs State of Andhra Pradesh and others etc. etc. and the related guidelines and criteria as may be issued by the AICTE, UGC or the Central Government from time to time.

As you are aware, All India Council for Technical Education has been mandated under the AICTE Act, 1987 to ensure maintenance of norms and standards with regard to technical education in the country. In exercise of this mandate, the Council insists on fulfillment of the minimum requirements prescribed for imparting technical education by the institution so that quality of course is not compromised and stakeholders are satisfied. The Council also undertakes an annual Inspection of the institutions and conveys deficiencies to them for rectification.

It has been observed however that notwithstanding the Council's repeated advice to comply with minimum norms and standards, many institutions continue to be complacent about taking steps to remedy the deficiencies.

Such institutions suffer from critical deficiencies of faculty in proper cadre ratio, qualification, experience and other requirements. Feed back of students with regard to quality of education imparted by such institutions has evoked grave concern. The Expert Committees, following holistic appraisal during inspections, have also pointed out severe shortcomings.

The institution has been found to be suffering from several deficiencies, which are listed in Annexure-A for your perusal. Shortage of faculty is of gravest concern.

The deficiencies in respect of faculty (including proper cadre ratio & qualification etc.) could have rendered your institution liable for punitive action including being placed in no admission/ reduced intake category. However the Council has decided to take a lenient view and give you yet another last opportunity to rectify the deficiencies particularly with regard to faculty shortage, proper cadre ratio & requisite qualification. 




